

MDM VS MTD

MDM is just for *device management*. It doesn't provide on-device threat detection, analysis or remediation out of the box. It can't block phishing, stop malware, guide users to remove threats, or scan WiFi networks for attacks.

**MTD is for security, MDM is for management.
Combining them gives you the best protection.**
